

## Intervention Referral Protocol

Student behavior appears

- Teacher begins checklist and documentation
  - a. Teacher selects 3 strategies-2 positive and 1 adverse
  - b. Document time and location of targeted behavior
  - c. Tracks for success- **2 weeks**
- If there is little to no change in targeted behavior after two weeks:
  - a. Teacher meets with student and choose 3 different strategies **together** and implement for **two additional weeks**.

These steps are to be done in the classroom for the duration of 4-6 weeks

- Re-asses, if there is little to no change then refer for tier 2 intervention
  - a. Referral brought to SST meeting where the referral will be discussed and the ARSW will do observations to help determine Tier 2 intervention

Students may be referred for Tier 2 Intervention by the office if they have:

- 2 or more office referrals of physical aggression, fighting, serious threats or self-harm
- 4 office referrals- insubordination, disrespect, defiance, destruction of property, technology

### Tier 2 Intervention Cycle:

- Intervention will be determined and discussed with the classroom teacher
- Interventions will be tracked and data collected for 2-3 weeks
- A Tier 2 checklist will be given to the teacher for data collection

### Tier 3 Intervention:

- After 2-3 weeks intervention will be re-assessed
- If there is little to no change student will be referred for a Tier 3 action plan that may include but not limited to:
  - Formal Behavior Plan
  - Crisis safety plan
  - Additional Intervention Strategies
