

	<b>IB Normal Track</b>
Summary	Under this track, EDPS would work directly with IB to obtain their own authorization to run IB programs in the district.
Time Frame	Normally takes about 2.5 years. We could run the building as IB beginning 2017/18 but the full authorization will not occur for 2.5 years.
Governance	EDPS would maintain full governance over the entire program.
Student Enrollment	All students would enroll with EDPS. We could offer Schools of Choice for the program or create a Shared Educational Entity that would allow students from other districts to attend.
Administration	EDPS would hire the administration for the IB program. Existing administrators could apply to work in the IB program, as required under reconstitution.
Teachers	EDPS would hire all of the teachers. Existing teachers could apply to teach at the IB program, similar to what was done when ALP was opened, and to meet the requirements of reconstitution.
Support Staff	EDPS would continue to provide clerical, custodial, maintenance, security, paraprofessionals, and other support personnel for the IB program.
Finances	EDPS would run the IB program like all of its other schools and would include the IB in the normal fiscal processes.
Student Discipline	Students in IB would follow the EDPS code of conduct. The discipline processes for the students would be completely handled by EDPS.

Per Pupil Funding	The per pupil funding for each student in the IB would be the FTE for EDPS.
Special Education Services	EDPS would provide full Special Education Services for all students
Marketing	EDPS would be fully responsible for marketing the IB program. While it is a well-known program, we obviously would be building our own reputation over time.
