









M-STEP Read by Grade 3 Law Indicators












M-STEP Math - Grade 3




















M-STEP Science - Grade 5







PSAT & M-STEP Grade 8 PSAT Grades 9 and 10


In accordance with the State School Aid Act, summative assessments for English language arts (ELA) and mathematics shall be administered to all public school pupils in grades 3-11. The Michigan Department of Education has chosen to administer the **College** Board's PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 to students in grades 8, 9, and 10 to fulfill this requirement. The PSAT must be taken on the scheduled state testing day. The **PSAT 8/9 replaced the M-STEP ELA and Mathematics assessment**

in grade 8 and is included in Michigan's accountability system along with the grade 8 M-STEP science and social studies.



















MME – Grade 11

The Michigan Merit Examination (MME) includes three components:


the SAT[®] with Essay college readiness assessment, ACT[®] WorkKeys® work skills assessment, and the Michigan Student Test of Educational Performance (M-STEP) in science and social studies.

These three components provide a measure of individual performance based on Michigan's high school content standards as well as college and career readiness.
















ACT WorkKeys

ACT WorkKeys is a job skills assessment system measuring real-world skills, designed to support economic and workforce development programs. The MME ACT WorkKeys component consists of three tests: Workplace Documents, Applied Math, and Graphic Literacy. Skills assessed by ACT WorkKeys are valued by Michigan employers, colleges, and technical training institutions.



MI-Access

MI-Access is Michigan's alternate assessment system and is designed for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities, and whose IEP (Individualized Education Program) Team has determined that general assessments, even with accommodations, are not appropriate.

MI-Access satisfies the federal requirement that all students with disabilities be assessed at the state level.



WIDA is the English language proficiency assessment administered to Kindergarten through 12th grade students who have been identified as English learners.

The assessments are given annually in Michigan to monitor students' progress in acquiring academic English.


NWEA MAP Growth Data Fall to Spring 2022 Longitudinal RIT Growth by Year




