



Symptom Checker for Students

Symptoms of possible COVID-19 in students include the following. These symptoms should be **new or different/worse than baseline** for any existing chronic illness.

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a **change** in their cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with fever

If your child shows any of these symptoms, DO NOT send the child to school. Call your building's principal. It takes ALL of us to keep our students and staff safe and healthy!
