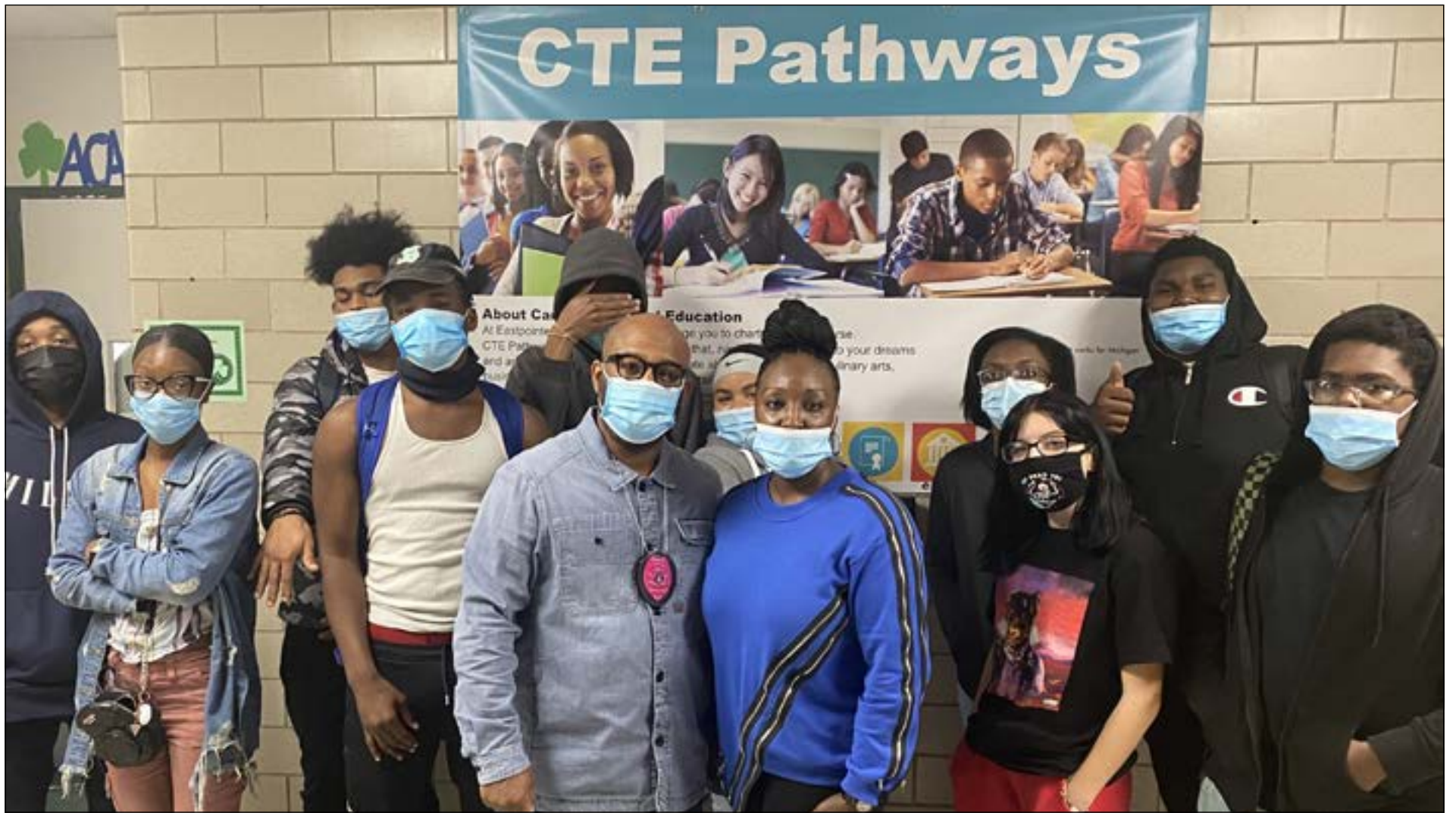

According to the City of Eastpointe's job description; the main function of a Police Service Aid is to perform non-sworn law enforcement tasks in order to free sworn officers from station duties. These functions include a

wide variety of tasks associated with the reception and support function of the Eastpointe Police Department. The role of a Public Safety Aide is multifaceted and demands an excellent multitasking ability. The public safety curriculum here at EHS has prepared our students for this opportunity by introducing them to workplace competencies such
